

No cell phones, airpods, Bluetooth headphones, or smart watches are allowed to be in use at Commerce Middle School during the school day. Cell phones must remain home or be turned off and stored in the student's backpack during the entirety of the school day.



- Clothing that does not include pictures, emblems, or writings that are lewd, offensive, vulgar, or obscene.
- Clothing that does not advertise or depict tobacco products, alcoholic beverages, drugs, or any other prohibited substance.
- Pants must fit appropriately around the waist. No sagging.
- Shorts, skirts, and dresses must be no higher than fingertip length.
- CMS prohibits crocs, flip-flops, sleeveless shirts, spaghetti straps, pajama pants, volleyball tights, hats, caps, and sunglasses.
- Tops cut low in the front, back, or side are prohibited.
- No skin should show between the bottom of blouse and top of pants when arms are extended above head.
- Students are not allowed to wear hoods on their heads anywhere in the school building.

No lockers at CMS. Students will carry their backpacks from class to class.

Chromebooks stay overnight charging at CMS this school year.

Tutoring will be on Wednesdays, starting in September. You will be notified if your child requires tutoring at any time during the school year.



### Parking and entrance during school day for front office

 Front office parking is in the front of the front office entrance (directly on Culver St.)

### Arrival and Dismissal for car-riders

- Car-rider drop off and pick up will be in the main parking lot on the west side of the school building.
- During arrival, students will walk down the front sidewalk, and enter the building through the front entrance.
- NO CARS WILL BE ALLOWED TO DROP OFF AT THE BUS DROP OFF!
- PLEASE DO NOT DROP STUDENTS OFF IN THE ROAD!

## Parking and entrance during evening events

- Sporting events, pep rallys, and any other event held in the gym will require parking in the main parking lot. Please park in designated parking spots; do not park in lanes.
- Events held in the school building (Meet the Teacher, Open House, 8th Grade Graduation, etc.) will require parking in the main parking lot, but visitors will enter through the front entrance of the building (bus entrance).
